The **Junior Faculty Development Program** (**JFDP**) provides university instructors with a one-semester opportunity to experience teaching practices and curriculum development at universities in the United States. JFDP Fellows observe courses at leading universities, participate in professional conferences and seminars, and undergo practical training in their field of study.

Program Objectives:

The primary and distinct goal of the JFDP is to provide university instructors with training in curriculum development and teaching methodology. JFDP Fellows work closely with faculty mentors from host universities to outline new courses in their fields of study, to gather new teaching materials, and to enlighten U.S. faculty and students on teaching practices in their home countries. American Councils, our NGO partner, is responsible for placing Fellows at U.S. host universities and for providing logistical support for the Fellows throughout their stay in the United States.

Program Eligibility Requirements:

- Citizen of Bosnia-Herzegovina
- Currently teaching full-time at an institution of higher education in BiH
- At least 2 years of professional experience as a university lecturer or administrator
- Highly proficient in written and oral English
- Able to begin the JFDP in the United States in January 2010
