

Aims of JoinEU-SEE

- to contribute to and facilitate the mutual enrichment of societies by fostering the development of qualifications of men and women in order for them to possess appropriate skills, especially in relation to the labour market, and to develop open-mindedness and international experience
- to promote the mobility of third country students, academics and researchers with a background of academic excellence, in particular from vulnerable groups, in order to offer them the opportunity to obtain qualifications as well as experience in the European Union
- to foster the development of both human resources and the international co-operation capacity of higher education institutions in the third countries by contributing to an increase in mobility flows between the EU and third countries on the basis of the principles of non-discrimination and equal opportunities

Who can apply?

Students and staff members of all partner universities, both from EU and Western Balkan countries, as well as other Nationals of Western Balkan countries, can apply for scholarships.

Types of scholarships and duration

Level of mobility	Duration	Allowance
Undergraduate	1 sem. or 10 months	1.000 € per month
Master	1 sem., 1 year or 22 months	1.000 € per month
Doctorate	6, 10 or 34 months	1.500€ per month
Post-doctorate	6 or 10 months	1.800 € per month
Staff	1 month	2.500 € per month

The scholarship includes a monthly allowance (see above), tuition fee (where applicable), travel costs and insurance (travel, health, accident).

Fields of Study

All universities in the JoinEU-SEE consortium are comprehensive universities that offer a wide range of studies which are open to participants of the exchange programmes. At the same time, the academic needs and special offers of universities are taken as the basis for the mobility frame.

Target Group I*

Students and staff registered/employed at a Western Balkan partner university. They need to hold the nationality of one of the Western Balkan partner countries**.

Target Group II*

1. Nationals of Western Balkan countries registered at a higher education institution in one of the 7 Western Balkan partner countries** not included in the JoinEU-SEE network or
2. Nationals of Western Balkan countries** having obtained a university degree or equivalent at an institution in a Western Balkan partner country**. This includes the possibility of providing mobility opportunities to graduates already working in public administration, public and private enterprises

Target Group III*

Nationals of Western Balkan countries** who are in particularly vulnerable situations. For example:
1. having a refugee status or asylum beneficiaries (international or according to the national legislation of one of the European recipient countries) or
2. it can be proved that they have been the object of unjustified expulsion from university on racial, ethnic, religious, political, gender or sexual inclination or
3. they belong to an indigenous population targeted by a specific national policy or IDPs (Internally Displaced Persons)

Target Group I

Students and staff who hold the nationality of one of the EU and Candidate countries and are registered at one of the EU partner universities are eligible to apply.

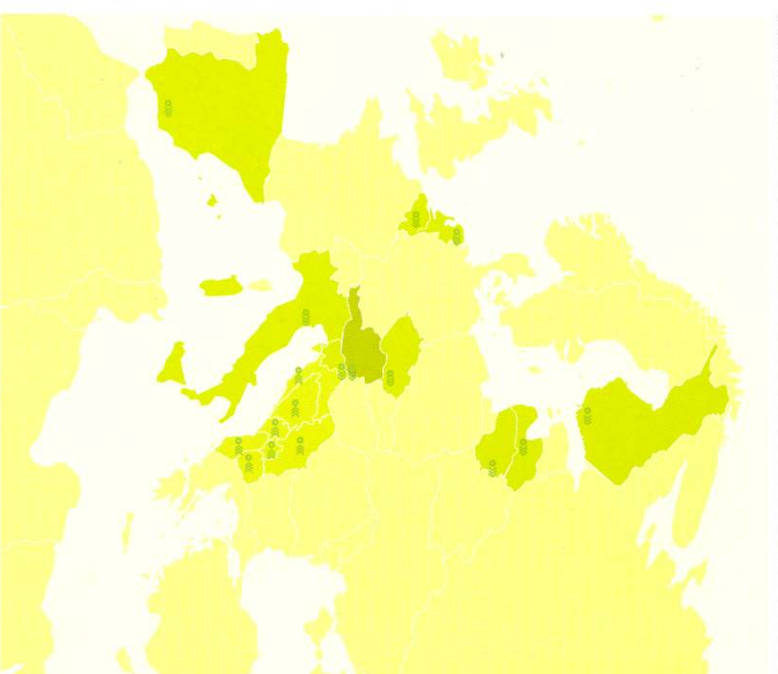
